- Accountability and transparency of City's operations including the activities of senior management [s.224 (d.1)]

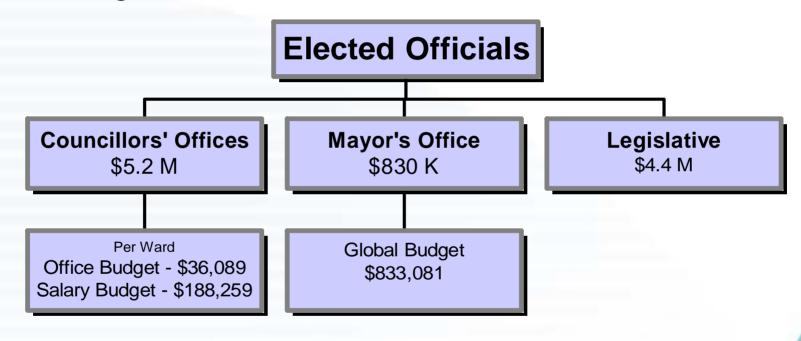
Support Statutory Role of Mayor

Total Budget=\$10.4 M





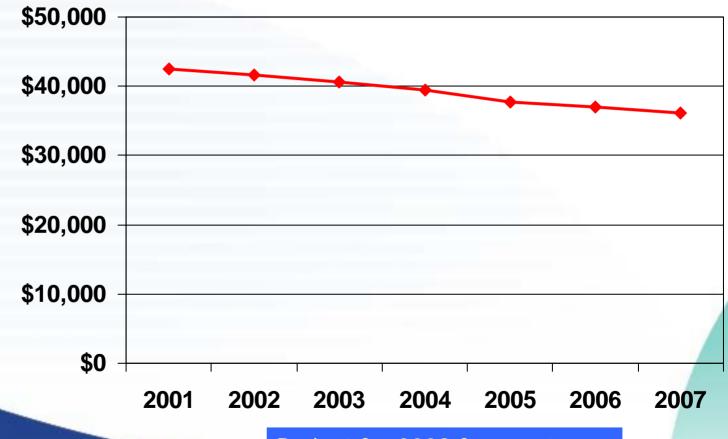

Office Budget per Councillor Inflation adjusted 2007\$

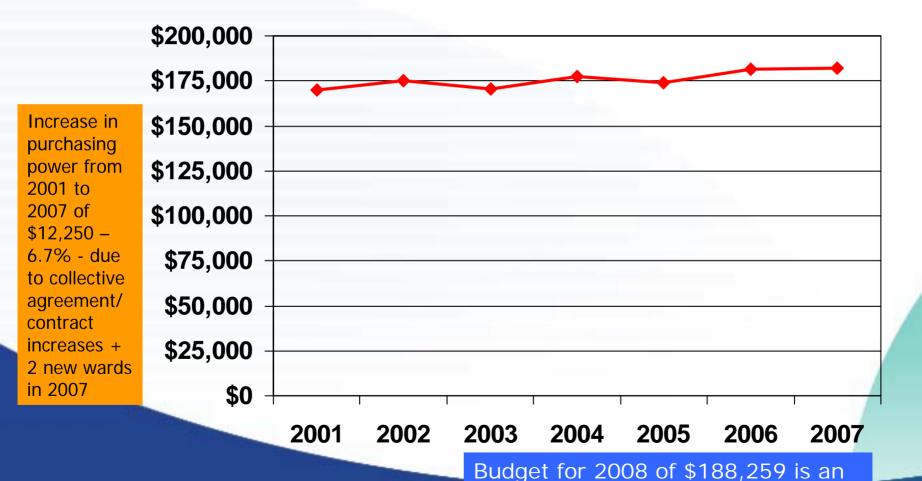




Budget for 2008 frozen at 2007 level of \$36,089



Staff Salary Budget Per Councillor Inflation adjusted 2007\$

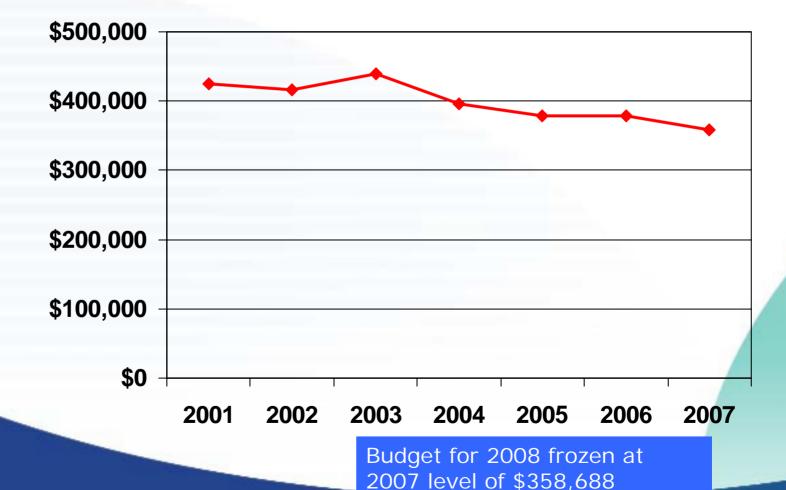


increase from 2007 level of 3.3%



Mayor's Office Non-Compensation Budget Inflation adjusted 2007\$

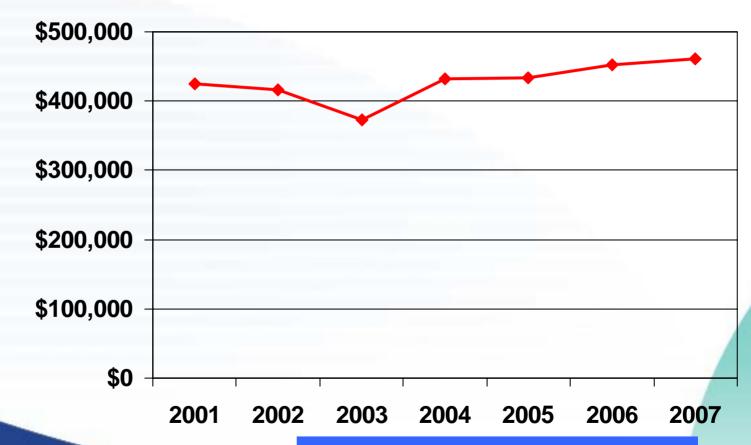
Decrease in purchasing power from 2001 to 2007 of \$66,540 – 18.6%





Mayor's staff Budget Inflation adjusted 2007\$

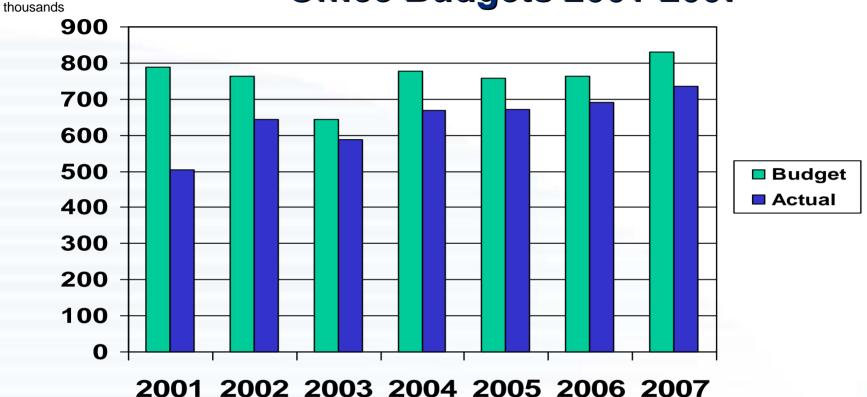
Increase in purchasing power from 2001 to 2007 of \$35,205 – 7.6% - due to collective agreement/contract increases

Elected Officials Historical Spending Office Budgets 2001-2007

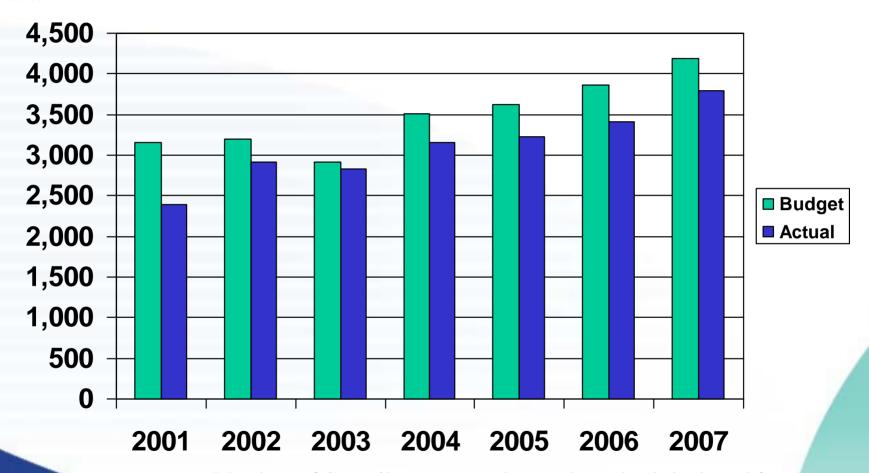


Members of Council cannot spend more than what is budgeted for their offices and are personally liable for a deficit in their budgets.



Elected Officials Historical spending Salary Budgets 2001-2007

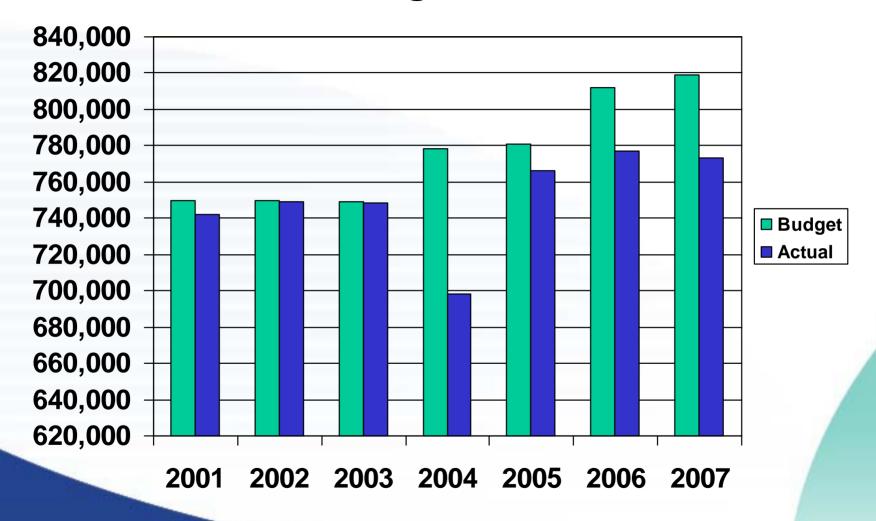

Mayor's Historical spending Global Budget 2001-2007





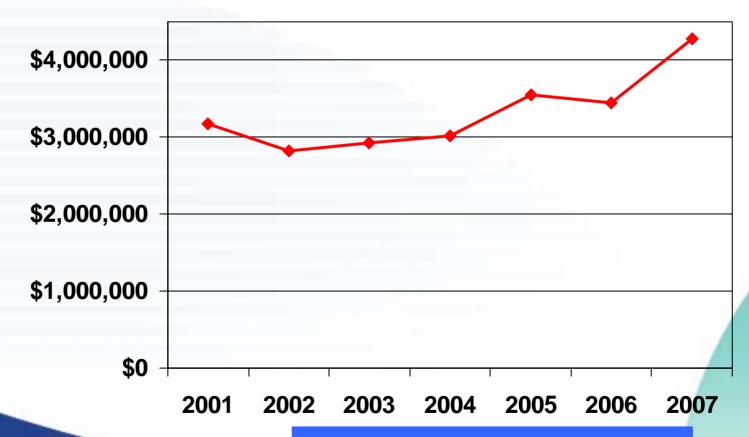

Legislative Budget Inflation adjusted 2007\$ (000's)

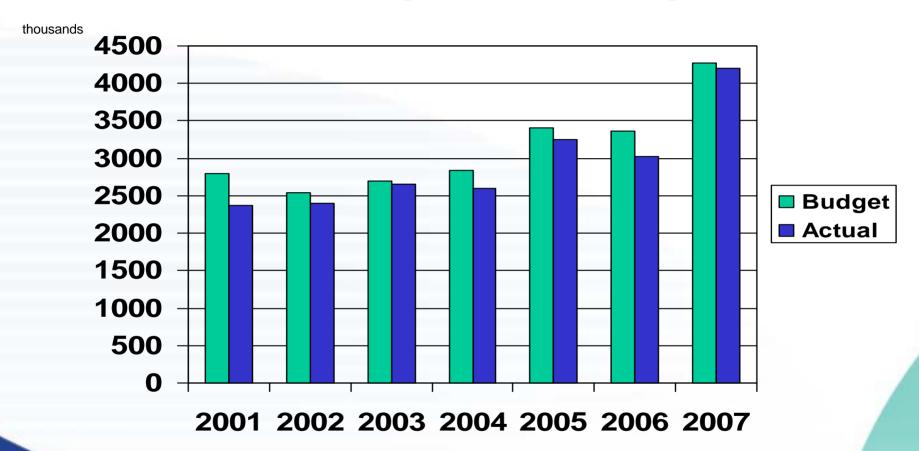
In 2007 two new wards were added



Budget for 2008 of \$4.4 million an increase over 2007 of 2.6%



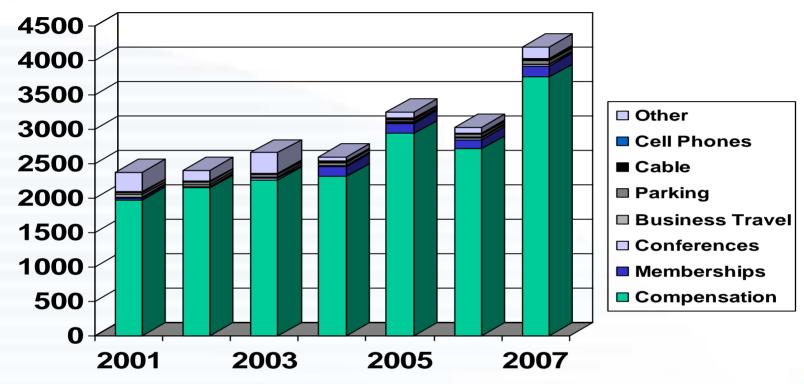
