Transit Vehicle Capacity

Vehicle type	Vehicle capacity		
Bombardier Talent BR643 DMU	Each Talent train is made up of of three cars and can carry 135 seated plus 150 standing customers.		
(Inverse or high floor)	Can carry between 41 and 48 customers seated plus approximately 20 standees. Council-approved service capacity standards allow for an average of up to 45 customers on board each of these buses at the busiest point during the busiest hour in peak periods.		
60-foot articulated bus	Can carry 54 customers seated plus approximately 45 standees. Council-approved service capacity standards allow for an average of up to 70 customers on board each of these buses at the busiest point during the busiest hour in peak periods.		

Greenboro Park and Ride has 678 parking spaces and usage is at capacity. The first trip to downtown departs at 5:16 (Route 97) and the last trip from downtown arrives at 3:13 (Route 97).
