Private Road Naming Application Submission Requirements and Information



This information package has been prepared to assist with the submission of a **Private Road Naming Application** as required by City of Ottawa Addressing By-law 2014-78. This application, to be completed and submitted to the City, must be accompanied by the plans and documentation described below. Please check off boxes (□) to ensure submission requirements have been met.

	 □ An application form completed in full □ Proof of ownership of the land (a copy of the deed or an equivalent document that clearly specifies the full current legal description, PIN number and ownership) □ Site Plan (as submitted during the Site Plan Control approval process) showing • location of the present and/or proposed private road(s) • main entrance of the building(s) or unit(s) • pedestrian walks • parking areas, aisles and driveways The Site Plan, drawn to scale, must be submitted in the following formats:

2) Selection of Private Road Names

- List the proposed private road name(s) in order of preference, and provide background information (origin, history, etc.) related to each name. It is recommended that you propose alternates in case the first choice is not available/suitable. The Building Code Services Branch will review the proposed names to ensure they comply with the City's street naming criteria.
- Please indicate if a suggested name is in recognition of an individual. If it is the first name, last name or first/last name of a person, you must apply for approval under the Commemorative Naming Policy. For a complete list of the commemorative naming criteria and a Commemorative Naming Application form, contact namingottawa@ottawa.ca.
- The private road name will be assigned the street type designation "Private" ("privé" in French), except in limited circumstances (e.g. lands under federal jurisdiction) where an approved alternate street type designation may be approved by the Director, Building Code Services Branch.
