I/we understand and agree that deletion from the list of Private Property Officers can occur for improper use of the City of Ottawa's Parking Infraction Notices, failure to appear in court when required, failure to adhere to the rules and regulations of the Private Property Parking Enforcement Program of the City, complaints as to improper conduct or where, in the opinion of the City, it is in the interest to make such deletions.
